. Various hints as to Ford's plans for the Mustang SS have survived through the years. A magazine article mention, a model car produced, even an SS badge. Among the rumors that circulate is that Ford had already started production of the Mustang SS, started delivering cars to dealerships, and then had to send out employees to pull the SS badging and add the Mustang GT decals seen on early 1982 model year GTs.
